### IO2 Induction Training Programme

- The In-service Training Programme for Community and Adult Educators has finally been produced in all partner languages and will soon be available online as a handbook in pdf format for printing and as a flipbook for online use to harness the full potential of the online learning environments.

### Transnational Training Event in Vauréal, France

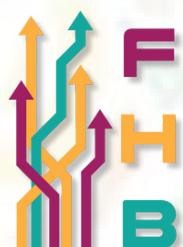
The material developed has been tested and presented at the Single Story LTTA in Vaureal, France, in November 2022. Educators from all over Europe attended the 3-day transnational event to improve their knowledge of African storytelling and develop their digital skills.

## What's next?

**IO3 Digital Repository and MOOC** - Partners are currently working on the finalisation of the MOOC platform, which will provide access to the Digital Storytelling Curriculum and the Induction Training Programme, as well as an online library comprising digital African stories and a collection of OERs to support African storytellers to grow the reach of their stories.

**Final Conference** - A final conference will be hosted in France on 17.05.2022. Partners will come together to officially launch the Single Story project materials with education providers and policy makers to recognise the value of incorporating the African Storytelling into mainstream education.

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
